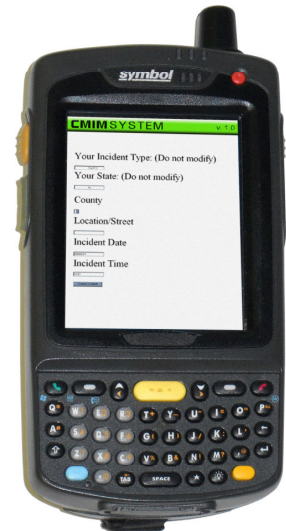


## Civilian Military Incident Management System
